**ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION TO REQUIRE  
ELECTRONIC SERVICE OF PLEADINGS AND NOTICES**

On this day came on to be heard the *Application to Require Electronic Service of Pleadings and Notices* (“Application”) filed by Resolution Oversight Corporation, Special Deputy Receiver of the Grand Court Order of Calanthe (“SDR”). The Special Deputy Receiver appeared by and through its counsel. Having considered the Application and the recommendation of the Special Master, the Court finds that the Application should be granted.

Having considered the Application, the Court finds as follows:

1. The *Order of Reference to Master* (“Order of Reference”) provides that motions filed pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 443.015 are referred to the Special Master appointed in this proceeding;

2. Notice of the Application was provided in accordance with TEX. INS. CODE §443.007 (d) and the Order of Reference;

3. No objections to the Application were filed;

4. The Court has jurisdiction over the Application and the parties affected hereunder;  
and

5. The Special Deputy Receiver’s Application should be granted in all respects.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

1. The Affidavit of Ernesto Garza is admitted as Exhibit 1 and the Application is GRANTED in all respects.

2. It is ORDERED that all parties in interest and parties requesting notice provide an e-mail address to the undersigned counsel to the SDR.
3. It is ORDERED that all parties in interest and parties requesting notice serve by e-mail all pleadings, pleas, motions, applications to the court for an order, notices and any other matter required to be serviced unless such party files a motion for leave of Court to use some other authorized method of service and the Court grants such motion.
4. It is ORDERED that the SDR may, at its sole discretion, provide notice of a filing in the Receivership Proceeding made by a party in interest, party requesting service, or any other individual or entity that is not represented by counsel;
5. It is ORDERED that the SDR, by the undersigned counsel, maintain a current list of the e-mail address for all parties and provide said list to all new parties; however, the parties on the list are responsible for providing notice of any changes to their e-mails to the SDR and the undersigned counsel.
6. It is ORDERED that the SDR will post on the Calanthe estate website all documents filed in this Receivership Proceeding
7. This order constitutes a final judgment fully resolving all issues relating to the Application.
